One of those coming to a close was the remediation of the former Kilgard Brick Plant on the Sumas First Nation. It was an honour and pleasure working with the Sumas First Nation on this project, and on a site that has a long and meaningful history with the community.

Our team also recently had an opportunity to be a part of a series of Indigenous Cultural Awareness webinars hosted by Indigenous Treaty Partners (ITP). We are working closely with ITP and The Barrington Consulting Group to develop our Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP) to help guide us in how we can participate meaningfully in Truth and Reconciliation, both in our personal and professional lives, and in the work we do with Indigenous peoples and businesses.
